Parkett is delighted to invite the young Swiss artist Pamela Rosenkranz, introduced in its most recent publication, to curate a Carte Blanche presentation at its Zurich exhibition space. The artist has assembled her selection of some fifty Parkett Editions made by artists for Parkett to form a most unusual array of works.

Rosenkranz's selection spans work from the past thirty years in a variety of media, including photography, prints, sculpture, and video by such artists as Jennifer Allora & Guillermo Calzadilla, Pawel Althamer, John Baldessari, Matthew Barney, Louise Bourgeois, Sophie Calle, Trisha Donnelly, Peter Fischli/David Weiss, Nan Goldin, Wade Guyton, Roni Horn, Jeff Koons, Sherrie Levine, Paul McCarthy, Bruce Naumann, Cady Noland, Philippe Parreno, Rosemarie Trockel, Adrian Villar Rojas, Danh Vo, and many more.

The presentation gives not only an insight into the nature of Pamela Rosenkranz's artistic approach, it also provides an opportunity to rediscover lesser known, older and out-of-print works through the eyes of a young, conceptually oriented artist. The latest Artists' Editions by Marc Camille Chaimowicz, John Waters, and her own "Survivor Series" will also be on view.

Pamela Rosenkranz, born in 1979, lives in Zurich. Her spectacular installation "Our Product" is currently installed in the Swiss pavilion at the Venice Biennale (until 22 November 2015). She is one of Switzerland's foremost young women artists.
