We are delighted to present “Small is Beautiful”, a thirty year survey of some one hundred selected works on view by appointment at Parkett in New York.

Included in this cabinet-like presentation are rare and available works from the Eighties, Nineties and the new Millennium made by artists for Parkett in all media. As the title suggests, a special feature of many works on view is their scale. “... *The diversity of the works on view offers a sense of what artists can do with the challenge of how to distill their practices into a single, compact object or image ...*” noted Philip Tinari, director of Beijing’s UCCA, on the occasion of Parkett’s exhibition at that venue.
